



# Join First Nations Launch

Support the team experience for American Indian Science and Engineering Society Chapters, Tribal Colleges and Universities, and Native American-Serving Nontribal Institutions as they gather together for a national high-powered rocket launch.

Additional funding enhances the student experience and expands the scope of First Nations Launch (FNL) funding. Please note, we would like to specify that any external funding should not replace FNL project funds. External funds should support any expenses above and beyond the materials, supplies, and travel funded through FNL.

## As part of FNL, each team is provided with:

- *\$4000 towards team project and travel expenses*
- *3 hotel rooms for 3 nights*
- *Friday breakfast and lunch, Saturday lunch and dinner*

External funding can expand teams' capabilities and resources and aid them as they complete their project. Teams may seek external funding for various items or certifications related to the launch, such as:

- **Stipend/Scholarship**
  - *Research Scholarship for each team member*
  - *Stipend for the team's mentor(s)*
- **Travel**
  - *Travel to and from Kenosha, WI for mentors, additional team members*
- **Materials and Supplies**
  - *Mobile tools (battery operated) for the rocket group (hammer, Dremel, drill, screwdriver, scale)*
  - *Traveling tool box to bring to launch weekend*
  - *Safety equipment and personal protective equipment*
- **Certification**
  - *Launch 2 Learn Workshop at academic institution*
  - *Level I Rocket, Motor, and Certification Fee*
  - *Level II Rocket, Motor, and Certification Fee*
- **Other**
  - *Outreach events (i.e. low-powered rocket event, displays, etc.)*
  - *Team shirts, jackets, etc.*

Students may seek additional funding from organizations such as:

- *Space Grant*
- *Academic Institutions*
- *Student Groups*
- *Industry*
